

Severe Weather Policy

- An airhorn will sound when lightning is within 8 miles.
- Upon hearing the alarm, all players, coaches, and bystanders must report to their cars.
 - Lexington Sporting Club's management team will also notify families via PlayMetrics and social media channels of the delay.
- There will be a 30-minute delay from the last lightning strike before the "all clear" sounds which is a rapid two ringing of the airhorn.
 - All updates will be sent via PlayMetrics and social media channels.
- Once the "all clear" is sounded, the fields are open for use.

Medical

- All major sporting events at our complex are staffed by medical personnel (athletic trainers).
- The AEDs will be with our athletic trainer on duty and two designated spots available to staff, coaches, and team staff/Game Day Managers.
- During training, if a player is injured, the coach may notify our athletic training staff via radio. Each field has its own radio.
